

About Our Patients

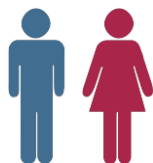

Overall, our **patient population** was 50% female and 50% male, but varied by diagnosis.

Our patient population also varied greatly by **age** – ranging from 18 to 99 years old, with an average age of 68 years.

The majority of our **spinal injury** patients (66%) had non-traumatic injuries. Among our **brain injury** patients, 44% sustained a traumatic injury and 56% a non-traumatic injury. In addition, 94% of our patients with lower extremity limb loss had a unilateral **amputation**, 6% bilateral.
