

# About Our Patients

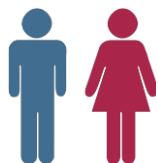
In 2018, 2,010 individuals and their families chose Kessler Institute - Saddle Brook campus for their inpatient rehabilitation. Although their diagnoses and rehabilitation needs were different, they shared a common goal: **to gain the skills, strengths and strategies to rebuild their lives.**

Patients were admitted to Kessler Institute with a range of **diagnoses.**

Overall, our **patient population** was 48% female and 52% male, but varied by diagnosis.

Our patient population also varied greatly by **age** – ranging from 18 to 100 years old, with an average age of 70 years.

The majority of our **spinal cord injury** patients (90%) had non-traumatic injuries. Among our **brain injury** patients, 39% sustained a traumatic injury and 61% a non-traumatic injury. In addition, 85% of our patients with lower extremity limb loss had a unilateral **amputation**, 15% bilateral.
